Let me not become that which I use. Lord Jesus, at the end of this day let me know that I am thy servant, and no other's.

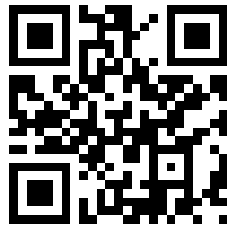
Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for me.
